	<b>Nov. 25</b> For victims of rape, that they may have the courage to speak out and receive support. That cultural beliefs, practices, and laws which enable rape may be changed, so that a stop is brought to the crime.	<b>Nov. 26</b> For an end to bullying of girls in school, including cyber bullying.	<b>Nov. 27</b> For courage for women who suffer injustice — forced labor, inadequate wages, or harassment — in their workplaces.	<b>Nov. 28</b> For protection of girls from forced child marriage and female genital mutilation.	<b>Nov. 29</b> For women and girls who are trafficked and sexually exploited.	<b>Nov. 30</b> That women and girls who experience violence may have the courage to report it, and be supported, rather than shamed or judged.
<b>Dec. 1</b> For an end to honor killings and other forms of femicide.	<b>Dec. 2</b> That boys and men may learn to treat girls and women with dignity and respect	<b>Dec. 3</b> That society may be more proactive in protecting girls and women from kidnapping	<b>Dec. 4</b> For end to the physical, sexual, emotional, and financial abuse of migrant women and girls.	<b>Dec. 5</b> That elderly women may experience tenderness, respect, and love.	<b>Dec. 6</b> That safety structures, such as police and courts, may respond with compassion to women and girls who experience violence.	<b>Dec. 7</b> For all women and girls who suffer war or conflict-related violence.
<b>Dec. 8</b> That verbal, emotional, and financial abuse may be eliminated and that relationships may be mutually uplifting.	<b>Dec. 9</b> For the elimination of all forms of violence against women and girls with disabilities.	<b>Dec. 10</b> That human rights of women and girls may be protected and promoted.
